

## **HALF -YEARLY OVERNIGHT CAMP FOR CUBS & BULBULS, SCOUTS & GUIDES**



## STAFF DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

### CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM ON COMPETENCY BASED ASSESSMENT FOR SELECT MENTORS

A two-day Capacity Building Programme on Competency Based Assessment was conducted for select mentors of NSN Memorial Senior Secondary School on 12.12.25 and 13.12.25, focusing on strengthening assessment practices. The workshop provided clarity on setting quality question papers, understanding effective assessment, and aligning questions with competency-based frameworks. Through interactive discussions and hands-on activities, teachers enhanced their understanding of CBSE assessment patterns and gained skills to design meaningful and effective evaluations.





### STEM LAB TRAINING

A training session was conducted on 16.12.25, for the science teachers of Std VI-VIII, introducing them to Robotics and Arduino. The session provided a basic understanding of robotics concepts, Arduino programming, and key ideas related to digital input and output. Hands-on demonstrations included a traffic light experiment for Grade VI and an introduction to motor drivers with the assembly of a robotic chassis kit for Grades VII and VIII. A video demonstration further enhanced understanding, making the session informative and practical. Overall, the session was interactive and informative, helping teachers gain both theoretical knowledge and practical exposure to robotics.



## THE INSTRUCTIONAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

The Instructional Leadership Programme for the Principals, vice-principals and HODs of the NSN Group of Schools, was conducted on 18.12.25 and facilitated by Dr. Indira Subramanian. The session focused on strengthening leadership practices related to teaching, learning, and assessment, and included an engaging LEGO Serious Play activity to reflect on leadership challenges. Key topics such as the distinction between leadership and management, creating supportive learning environments, coherence in instructional practices, higher-order thinking, change management, and Continuous Professional Development were discussed. The programme was highly enriching and reinforced the importance of student-centred instructional leadership.
