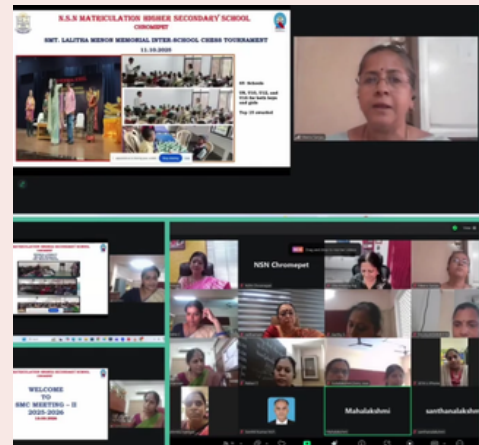
NEET AND JEE - PHYSICS DEMO SESSION
